Consider: IVF

D/C preload lowering agents: diuretics, nitrates, and morphine

Signs of middle cerebral artery stroke - Answer  * Contralateral hemiplegia
* Sensory involvement
* Aphasia (if dominant hemisphere involved)
* Neglect (if non-dominant hemisphere involved) (i.e. denial of weakness)
* Homonymous hemianopsia (loss of same visual field in both eyes)
