- A loadsheet must be completed in respect of each public transport flight.
- The person supervising the loading must prepare a loadsheet and sign it, to certify the aircraft has been properly loaded and to present it to the captain of the aircraft.
- Standard weights should normally be used, however
commanders may use their discretion to use actual weights
