## 200,000 Voices Will Be Heard!

WASHINGTON — More than 200,000 civil rights graduates can be credited with creating a turning point in American history.

As participants in the great March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom, they have given birth to a new national conscience which is demanding civil rights and equal employment for all Americans without delay.

There is no war of talking now how much the Aug. 28 march will stimulate the actions of Congress in conferring President Kennedy's civil rights program.

THERE IS no question, however, that the impact will be multitudes of civil rights marchers will linger on many a legislator's mind.

**WASHINGTON** — (AP) — On the eve of the greatest civil rights march in history, the Catholic bishops of the United States have reaffirmed that racial discrimination "cannot be reconciled with the truth that God has created all men with equal rights and equal dignity."

In a joint pastoral letter released by the National Catholic Welfare Conference and 100 other bishops, they urged the country to "bring its moral judgment on racial discrimination and segregation."

They called on all million members of the Catholic faith in the United States to "express eloquently that include the rights and responsibilities of all men and women."

A partial text of the letter follows:

"We reaffirm that segregation implies that people of one race are not fit to associate with another by subject of race and regardless of individual qualities..."
