Type V PFD--special use CORRECT ANSWERS Ex: deck suits, work vests, board sailing vests -special uses and locations

PFD label CORRECT ANSWERS -intended use of device -size of person it will fit -special care instructions -how to properly wear it -if its US coast guard approved
