class.

□ REVIEW the instructions with students for "Sequence" and "Weigh it out" and give

them a set amount of time to complete these activities. Spot check for

understanding.

□ Run the Limiting Government PowerPoint assisting students in completing the

guided notes as you go. Pause to check for understanding and clarify as

needed.

☐ DISTRIBUTE the activity sheet. Read each scenario with the class, discussing which

checks may apply to each fictional government system. For struggling students, you may want to give a hint about how many limits there are in each scenario. Then, have students fill out the boxes at the bottom of the

page to give their opinions.
