Calculate Net Force Worksheet

= 50 \text{ N}
\]
```

4. Determine direction:

```
\[
\theta = \tan^{-1}\left(\frac{40}{30}\right) = \tan^{-1}(1.33) \approx 53.13^\circ
\]
```

Thus, the net force is 50 N at approximately 53.13° above the horizontal.
