CLIA

ANSWER: Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988.

-This law requires any facility performing examinations of human specimens (e.g., tissue, blood, urine, etc.) for diagnosis, prevention, or treatment purposes to be certified by the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services.

Responsible Health Authority

ANSWER: -The RHA arranges all levels of health care and assures quality, accessible, and timely health services.

- -The RHA is on site at least weekly.
- -The RHA may be a physician, health administrator, or agency.
- -Clinical judgments rest with a single, designated, licensed, responsible physician
