Optometrist

Ophthalmologist

Works under direct supervision of a licensed doctor of optometry. Collects patient data, administers tests, and assists in office management. May assist with patient care examinations in contact lens, low vision, vision therapy, dispensing, and office management.

Anterior Chamber

Area inside the eye, behind the cornea, and in front of the iris. This area is filled with clear, watery fluid called aqueous humor

Aqueous Humor

Clear, watery fluid produced by the ciliary body. It fills the front part of the posterior chamber and the entire anterior chamber. Provides nutrients for the lens and posterior cornea and carries away waste products. It is also responsible for maintaining the intraocular pressure

Choroid

Consists primarily of blood vessels that nourish the retina so that it can continue to function. Sandwiched between the sclera and the retina
