

Civics Eoc Study Guide Florida

Baron de Montesquieu	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> French noblemen who came up with the idea of the <u>separation of powers</u> and <u>checks and balance</u>. Montesquieu concluded it was best to <u>divide the powers of government</u> into 3 parts (the legislative branch to make laws, the executive branch to carry out laws, and the judicial branch to interpret the laws), to keep government leaders from becoming too powerful or tyrannical. Each branch would depend on the cooperation of the others to do its job. These ideas are found in the <u>US Constitution</u>.
The Magna Carta	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Document that <u>limited the power of the king (limited monarchy)</u> by requiring him to protect certain rights of the nobles, such as having a trial by jury, and being taxed <u>without their consent</u> (found in our Bill of Rights).
The English Bill of Rights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A contract by the English Parliament to safeguard (protect) their rights and individual liberties (freedom) from royal abuses, therefore <u>limiting the powers of the king (limited monarchy)</u>. Some of the rights stated in the bill are: freedom of speech, right to bear arms, the right to petition the government, the right against excessive bail, and against cruel and unusual punishment (all found in our Bill of Rights).
The Mayflower Compact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Agreement made by the <u>Pilgrims</u> that came to America on the Mayflower ship. Together, they <u>wrote a set of rules to govern these settlers</u> (self-government), and <u>agreed to obey them and they got off the ship</u>.
Common Sense by Thomas Paine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Pamphlet</u> where Paine argued that it made no sense for the 13 colonies to be governed by the tiny and distant island of Great Britain. He <u>encouraged colonists to declare independence</u> during the American Revolution.
English Policies and Colonial Responses	<p>To pay for the French and Indian War, the <u>British imposed high taxes on the colonists without their consent</u> (no taxation).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>The Stamp Act</u> - taxes to pay for a government change required on all official documents, newspapers, pamphlets. The colonists <u>sent petitions</u> (formal requests) to the British Parliament to end this act and <u>boycotted</u> (refused to buy) <u>British goods</u>. The <u>British responded</u> (conceded) the act, but passed... <u>The Townshend Acts</u> - taxes on common items shipped to the colonies, such as paper, paint, glass, lead, and tea. The colonists <u>got more outraged and angered</u> by the British insisting on imposing taxes without their consent - "<u>No taxation without representation</u>". To try to keep the colonies under control, the <u>British sent more troops to America</u>, and obligated colonists to "<u>quarter soldiers</u>" (housing a city) in their homes. Eventually they repealed the Townshend Acts, but passed... <u>The Tea Act</u> - a tax on tea. <p>To protest the <u>Tea Act</u>, a group of colonists (<u> Sons of Liberty</u>) got dressed as Indians, boarded a ship, and <u>threw chests full of tea overboard</u>. As a response, the British passed...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>The Intolerable Acts</u> - basically stated that <u>whatever the British said had to be obeyed by the colonists without question</u>.
The Boston Tea Party	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>1st</u> - 12 of the 13 colonies met and agreed to keep protesting and boycotting the British, but a few months later the Revolutionary War began. <u>2nd</u> - Colonists agree to resist the British and formed the Continental Army. They sent the king an "olive branch" petition to reconcile and make peace, but they ignored them, and instead fought to fight the colonists. The colonists had enough of the British abuses and <u>agreed to end their relationship with the British and declare independence</u>.

PURPOSE OF THE CIVICS EOC

THE MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE CIVICS EOC ARE TO:

1. ASSESS STUDENTS' KNOWLEDGE OF CIVICS CONCEPTS AND SKILLS.
2. ENCOURAGE CRITICAL THINKING ABOUT GOVERNMENT AND CIVIC ENGAGEMENT.
3. PREPARE STUDENTS FOR ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THEIR COMMUNITIES AND THE POLITICAL PROCESS.

STRUCTURE OF THE CIVICS EOC

THE CIVICS EOC CONSISTS OF MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTIONS THAT COVER A RANGE OF TOPICS RELATED TO CIVICS EDUCATION. THE ASSESSMENT IS TYPICALLY DIVIDED INTO TWO MAIN SECTIONS:

KEY TOPICS COVERED IN THE CIVICS EOC

- **POLITICAL PARTIES AND ELECTIONS:** INSIGHT INTO THE ROLE OF POLITICAL PARTIES, THE ELECTION PROCESS, AND VOTER PARTICIPATION.
- **CIVIC ENGAGEMENT:** IMPORTANCE OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT AND ADVOCACY FOR ISSUES.
- **RIGHTS OF CITIZENS:** KNOWLEDGE OF CIVIL LIBERTIES AND HOW THEY ARE PROTECTED UNDER THE LAW.

MANAGE TIME WISELY

TIME MANAGEMENT IS CRUCIAL DURING THE TEST. STUDENTS SHOULD:

- PACE THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THEY CAN ANSWER ALL QUESTIONS.
- IF STUCK ON A QUESTION, MOVE ON AND RETURN TO IT LATER IF TIME PERMITS.

STAY CALM AND FOCUSED

MAINTAINING A CALM DEemeanor CAN SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT PERFORMANCE. STRATEGIES TO STAY CALM INCLUDE:

- TAKING DEEP BREATHS IF FEELING ANXIOUS.
- VISUALIZING SUCCESS AND MAINTAINING A POSITIVE MINDSET.

CONCLUSION
