Cultural Diffusion: the spread of cultural characteristics from one group to another

–ex: Paper from China to rest of world

Cultural Leveling: the process by which cultures become similar to one another; especially refers to the process by which US culture is being exported and diffused into other nations

–Eliminates differences between cultures

–ex: McDonalds/Coke—almost anywhere
