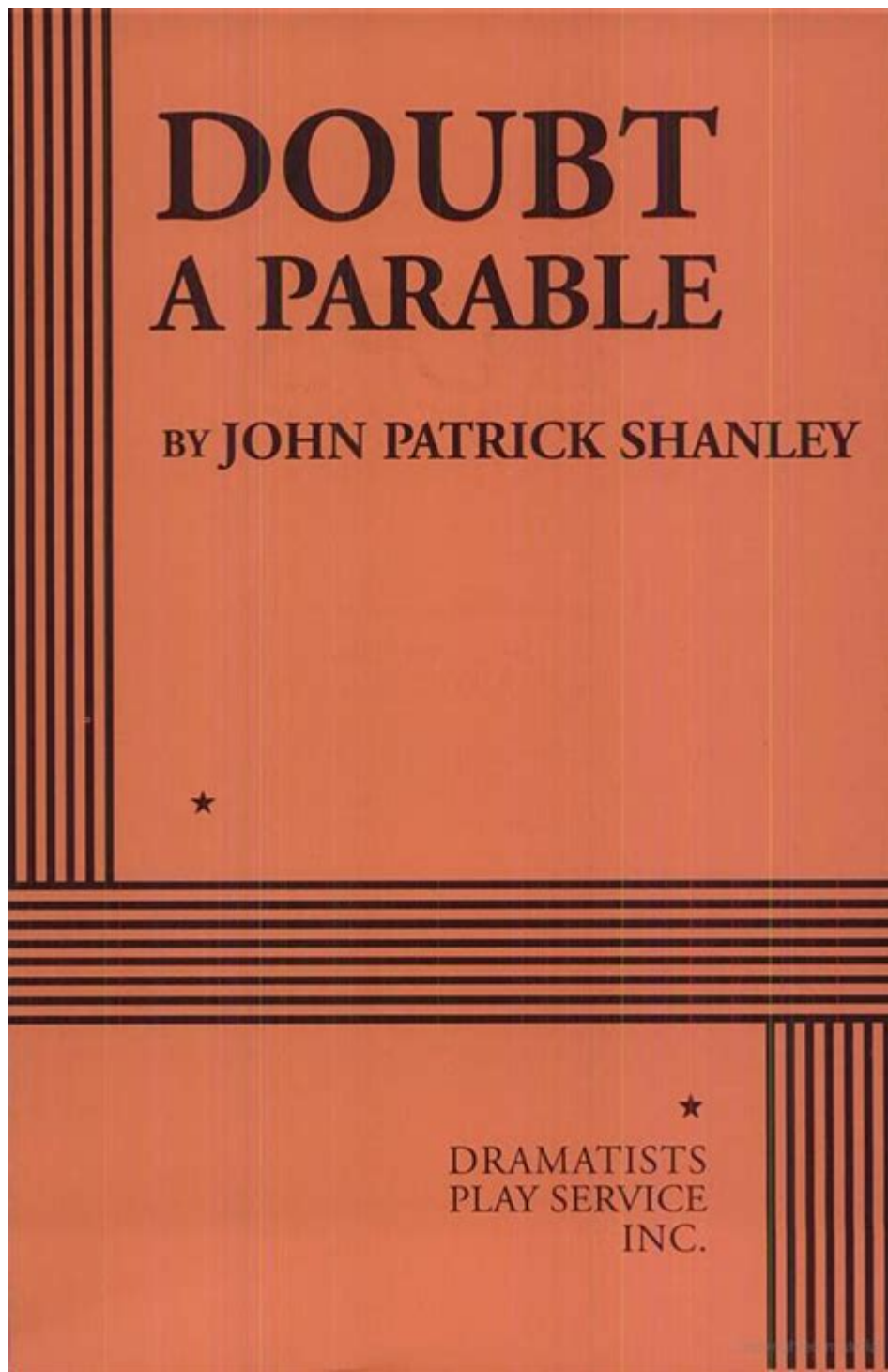


Doubt A Parable By John Patrick Shanley
