In the film we see Denny knocking down the wall trying add some variation to his home. When Rita swings the sledgehammer the hole ceiling and house collapses. Their home represents their marriage. Denny wants change and variation, but when Rita lends a helping hand, chaos. The airport is also symbolic, because Frank leads Rita there and then leaves her to walk down the long corridor. This is symbolic because Frank has shown Rita the way and guided her to her goal and given her a decision the one thing she's always wanted. Frank leaves her, and flies off to Australia, and Rita turns and begins to walk down a long airport corridor, because although she has already come along way, her journey is really only just beginning.

The play only has two characters, Frank and Rita. This is because the play script is just a Duologue with Frank and Rita telling us about the extra characters and their actions, but the film has a Multi-character cast so we actually see and hear the other characters as well as hear Frank and Rita's conversations about them, behind the characters backs. In the film we see and hear the other characters point of view and what they actually say rather than just hearing what Frank and Rita think about them and their slightly bias variations on what the other characters have said or done.<
