most of the time, the quality of the final glyph-ranges from white (common) to yellow (legendary)

These rates will determine the type of glyph. Whether the glyph will do damage, add health, increase stamina regen or increase armor, the essence rate is what will determine that. There are two lesser rates, damage (red) or buff (green). These lesser rates can be changed by which type of potency rate is used.

These rates will determine if the glyph is a buff to self or a debuff to target. To make a glyph a self-buff, you will need to forgo (green) or inferior (red) the essence rate. (buffing or increasing essence rates will have a different effects depending on if it is used for jewelry, armor or weapon.)

For example:
Dementia + Kudo (stun regen + inferior) will give reduced stamina cost or jewelry.
Dementia + Core (stun regen + inferior) will give stamina recovery on jewelry.
Dementia + Core (stun regen + buff) will add health-recovery on jewelry.
Swearing (Dementia + Kudo) will make it a weapon enchant that will deal additional damage to target.

*Lower potency rates that invest buffs may also lead to the jewelry/armor suit which keeps it a self-buff. e.g. Magica recovery on jewelry invested is reduced health/armor stat.

Notes:
- Changing a potency rate from fairly to inferior may change the type of glyph (purple, weapon or armor)
- Use common essence enchants, they will be tied to use of the three types, e.g. Reduced costs will only be useful on jewelry
