- 24 total multiple choice questions
- study vocabulary

**Part 2: Argument Essay**


- establish YOUR claim
- use evidence from at least 3 of the 4 texts
- include an opposing viewpoint (some people believe...)
- use TEAL
- 5 paragraphs (intro, body 1, 2, 3, and conclusion)

**Part 3: Text Analysis**

- write about how ONE literary device helps to develop the central idea of the text...use evidence!
- Example Literary Devices: conflict, imagery, characterization, simile...
- Example central ideas (what lesson do we learn or main character learn): don't judge a book by its cover, words have power, money can't buy happiness
- use TEAL
- 3 paragraphs (central idea, literary device, and conclusion)

**other tips:**

- go back and check the directions to check off that you included everything needed...if not add it to the bottom of the page
- include (Text..., Line...,) at the end of when you use evidence from the texts
- highlight as you read the texts to identify what pieces of evidence you could use
- Use paragraphs and punctuation
- study vocabulary (especially helpful for the multiple choice section of exam)
- TEAL stands for Topic, Evidence, Analysis, Link
- DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING BLANK!!!
