# **EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS**

- Lack of Representation: The absence of Black authors and historians in educational materials leads to a skewed understanding of history.
- CENSORSHIP: IN SOME CASES, DISCUSSIONS AROUND RACE AND RACISM ARE ACTIVELY DISCOURAGED IN CLASSROOMS, LIMITING STUDENTS' UNDERSTANDING OF SYSTEMIC ISSUES.

# CONSEQUENCES OF ERASURE

THE ERASURE OF BLACK HISTORY HAS FAR-REACHING CONSEQUENCES THAT IMPACT BOTH INDIVIDUALS AND SOCIETY AS A WHOLE.
