Consonant Pretest

Have students turn to page i. Tell students to look at the letter at the beginning of the line and \bigcirc (circle) the picture that begins with the same sound. Identify pictures if necessary. Have students complete pages i-iii independently.

Students who miss five or more items on this Pretest may not be ready to go on to new material and should instead complete *Explode The Code* Books A, B, and C at this time. Students who miss fewer than five items are ready for Book 1. Notice which letters, if any, were missed and incorporate them into review.
