WHEN TO APPLY: From March 4, 2009 To: April 7, 2009 APPLICATION FEE: \$60.00 Payable by mail by money order to DCAS (EXAMS), or payable online by credit card, bank card, or debit card. THE TEST DATE: The multiple-choice test is scheduled to be held on Saturday, June 20, 2009.	
The Notice of Examination is amended to extend the end of the filing period from March 24, 2009 to April 7, 2009 and change "Title 27" to "Title 29" in the NYC Administrative Code in the multiple-choice subsection of the THE TEST section.	
WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES: An Assignment Level 3 Supervising Fire Marshal (Uniformed) under general supervision, supervises the operation of a fire investigation squad as a Borough Command team or a special team or performs comparable duties at the headquarters of the Bureau of Fire Investigation. They oversee and manage the conduct of investigations into the causes, circumstances and origins of accidental and incendiary fires and/or accidents; personally respond to major fires and handle more difficult investigations; assign duties to, control and evaluate the work of Fire Marshals; coordinate the job training; review reports of investigations of fires; prepare and submit periodic reports of the unit's activities; prepare the maintenance of records and/or inventories; conduct surveillance; prepare felony complaints and assist the District Attorney in the preparation of cases for trial; interview attorneys and insurance adjusters investigating fires and explosions; authorize the issuance of subpoenas to witnesses and alleged perpetrators and take sworn statements from them; drive a Department vehicle; and perform related work. Special Working Conditions: Supervising Fire Marshals (Uniformed) may be required to work shifts including nights, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. Some of the physical activities performed by Supervising Fire Marshals and environmental conditions experienced are: wearing protective clothing, such as bunker suits, helmets, boots and breathing apparatus; crawling, crouching and standing, often for prolonged periods of time; and climbing stairs, ladders and fire escapes. (This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)	
THE SALARY: The current minimum salary is \$67,400 per annum. This rate is subject to change. There are ten assignment levels within this class of positions. Promotions will be made to Assignment Level 1. After promotion employees may be assigned to the higher assignment level at the discretion of the agency.	
HOW TO APPLY: If you believe you are eligible to take this examination, there are two ways to apply for this examination: (1) Online at the DCAS website: If you wish to apply online, go to the Online Application System (OAS) at www.dcas.nyc.gov and follow the on-line application instructions for electronically submitting your application and completing any required forms. The following methods of payment are acceptable: major credit card, bank card drawn from a bank account, or prepaid debit card which you may purchase online or at various retail outlets. (2) By mail: Refer to the "Required Forms" section below for the form that you must fill out. Return the completed form and the application fee to DCAS Application Unit, 1 Centre Street, 10th Floor, New York, NY 10007.	
DCAS will not accept applications in person from candidates.	
ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE EXAMINATION: This examination is open to each employee of an agency under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner, Department of Citywide Administrative Services who on the date of the multiple-choice test: (1) holds a permanent (not provisional) competitive appointment or appears on a Preferred List (see Note, below) for the title of Fire Marshal (Uniformed) and has served permanently in the title of Fire Marshal (Uniformed) for a period of not less than six months; and (2) is not otherwise ineligible.
