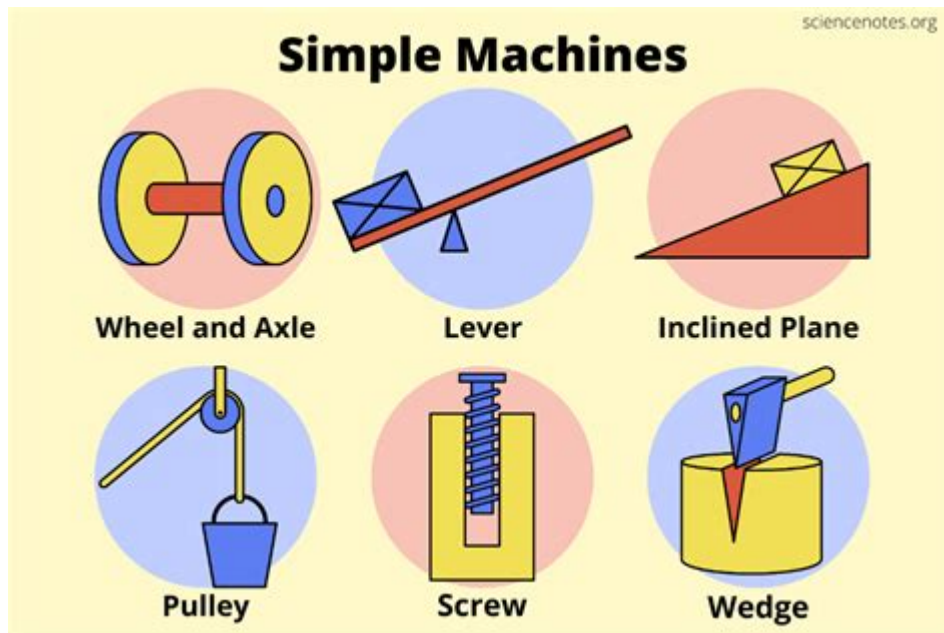


Examples Of Simple Machines For Kids
