OSHA requires that flammable storage cabinets be designed and constructed to have a fire resistance rating of at least 10 minutes, which means the cabinet should be able to contain a fire

within it for at least 10 minutes.

Aug $18,2005 \cdot A$ total of 120 gallons of a combination of class I, II, and IIIA materials may be stored in a single cabinet so long as the capacity of the cabinet is not exceeded; no more than 60 gallons of class I and II materials can be stored in a single cabinet.
