Trainer agrees to provide normal and reasonable care to maintain the health and well being of said horse. Care and services **NOT** included are: Farrier services, veterinary services, de-worming or vaccinations.

Emergency Care

If emergency treatment is needed, Trainer will attempt to contact Owner, but, in the event Owner is not reached, Trainer has the authority to secure emergency veterinary and/or farrier care. Owner is responsible to pay all costs relating to this care. Trainer is authorized as Owners agent to arrange billing to Owner.

In the event that the Trainer is unable to contact the Owner and must make a medical decision (ie, send the horse for surgery, put it down, etc.), outline the actions you (as Owner) want the trainer to take: _____

Risk of Loss

While the horse is boarded at Trainer's, Trainer shall not be liable for **ANY** injury, sickness, death or theft suffered by the horse of any other cause of action arising from or connecting to the boarding of the horse. Owner agrees to hold Trainer harmless for any loss or injury to said horse. All costs, no matter how catastrophic, connected with boarding, training, or for any other reason for which the horse is on the premises of Trainer, are to be borne by Owner.
