Retinal Detachment

Preoperative: Dependent position (lower) –
to prevent further detachment of the retina.

POSTOPERATIVE: DEPENDENT POSITION (UPPER)

– to lower the sclera and choroids by gravity and allow attachment of the area of retinal detachment.

After Ear Surgery: Unoperated Side –
to prevent trauma to operated side.

XI. PROCEDURES

ABDOMINAL ASSESSMENT

Purpose - determine the presence of mass, abnormal bowel sounds, lesions, and other abnormalities in the abdominal region.

Nursing Keypoints:

Position: **Dorsal Recumbent** Sequence: **(IAPP) Inspection, Auscultation, Percussion, Palpation.** Start palpating from RLQ, RUQ to LUQ, to LLQ

palpation is done last because it can possibly alter the bowel rhythms and may therefore give rise to abnormal sounds

No to palpation to patients with Wilms's tumor and abdominal Aortic Aneurysm

ARTERIAL BLOOD GAS ANALYSIS

Purpose - to monitor the patient's response to oxygen therapy and detects the presence of acid-base imbalance.
