Different types of government

Monarchy

Dictatorships

Extreme authoritarian governments are called totalitarian governments, or dictatorships. Citizens don't have any say about leaders or laws. They may be punished or killed for opposing the government. North Korea is a country run by a totalitarian government. Authoritarian governments often don't hold free and fair elections. And if they do, they may offer only one option – the ruling dictator – so it isn't a free election anyway.
