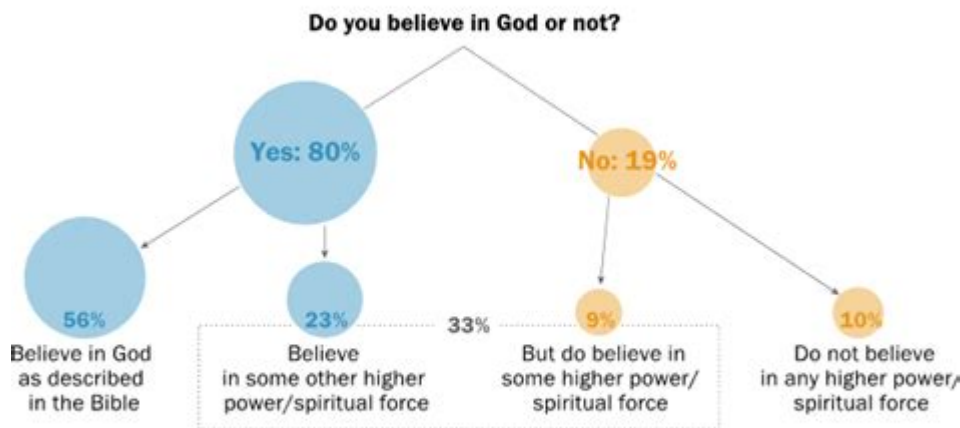


How Many People Believe In God
