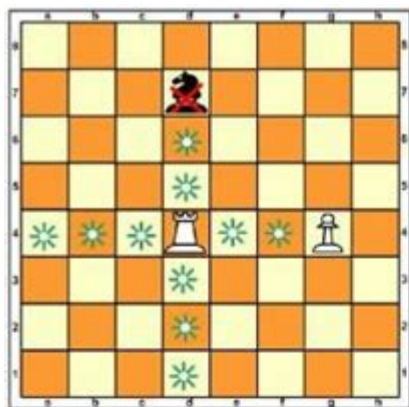
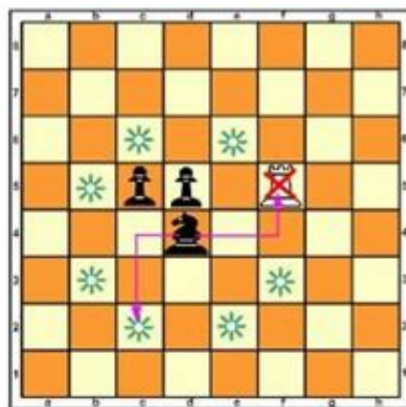


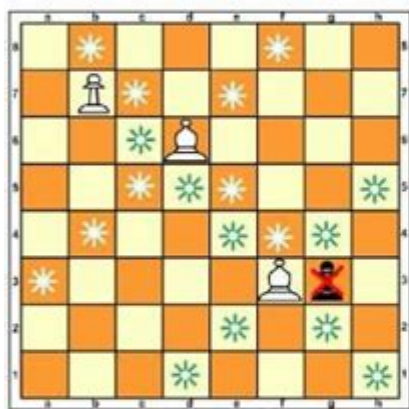
How Chess Pieces Move Diagram



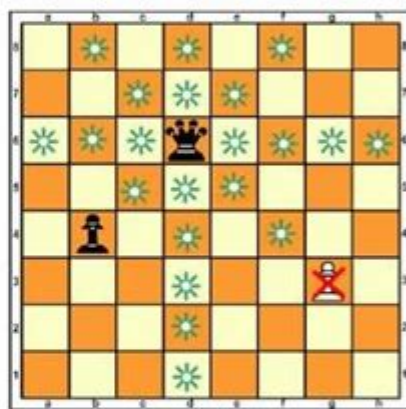
