- The Company intends to provide to the Student the training as offered through the Jackson Area College and Career Connection Early Middle College.
- 2. If the Student voluntarily terminates his/her employment with the Company prior to two (2) years following the date of the completion of the training, the Student and the Parent/Legal Guardian jointly and severally agree to reimburse the Company the cost of the training incurred (see Table 1) by the Company as determined by the schedule shown below:

MONTHS 7-12	75%
MONTHS 13-18	50%

The Student expressly authorizes the Company to deduct any reimbursement amount owned under the terms of this Agreement from any compensation owed by the Company to the Student at the time of or following voluntary termination of employment by the Student. The Student and/or the Parent/Legal Guardian shall promptly pay to the Company the full balance of any amount owed that is not deducted from compensation.
