Throughout the mid 1800's, techniques like heliography meant there was a long exposure wait for the picture to finally come through on a solid plate/surface, a technique invented by photographer, Nicéphore Niépce in 1826.

On this website, called 'Time: 100 Photos' there is a small paragraph explaining how Nicéphore Niépce came up with the idea of heliography.

"Searching for other ways to produce images, Niépce set up a device called a camera obscura, which captured and projected scenes illuminated by sunlight" (Time, Unknown).

The long exposure meant that buildings were the perfect use of experimentation when taking pictures as buildings stood still, so it was much easier for photographers to capture their most high-quality image without any interruptions.

Due to this rise in architectural photography, people started to get excitement from these pictures, making people focus more on architecture and have a new appreciation for it. With seeing all these different photography experiments, people were able to see the different ways architecture could be portrayed and even see architecture from a different, wider perspective.
