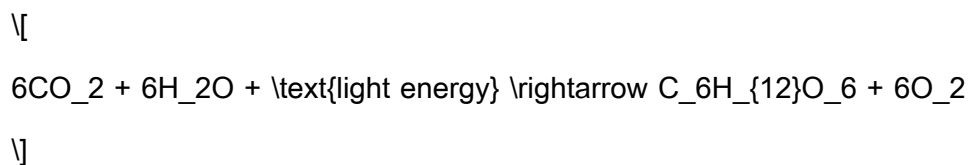
Substituting the radius:
