Which type of irony is used? Dramatic irony

4. In 'To Kill a Mockingbird', the main character, Scout is able to read at a young age as her father has taught her to read. When she starts school, one would expect a teacher to be pleased about that, but instead, her teacher is displeased and tells her to tell her father to stop teaching her.

Which type of irony is used? Situational irony
