$20 \div 5 = s$ or $s \times 5 = 20$,
 $s = 4$; 4 sisters

6 Harvey wrote letters to 10 of his friends. Each letter was 3 pages long. How many pages did Harvey write?

$10 \times 3 = p$, $p = 30$; 30 pages
