Lay /leɪ/ TRANSITIVE VERB PUT DOWN

Present participle *laying*
Past tense *laid*,
Past participle *laid*

to put something in especially a flat or horizontal position, usually carefully or for a particular purpose. E.g.:
She laid the baby on the bed.
He laid the tray down on the table.

Lie /laɪ/ INTRANSITIVE VERB POSITION

Present participle *lying*,
Past tense *lay*,
Past participle *lain*

to be in or move into a horizontal position on a surface. E.g.:
to lie in bed
to lie on a beach

Lie /laɪ/ VERB SPEAK FALSELY

present participle *lying*,
past tense *lied*,
past participle *lied*

to say or write something that is not true in order to deceive someone. E.g.:
Are you lying to me?
Don't trust her - she's lying.
