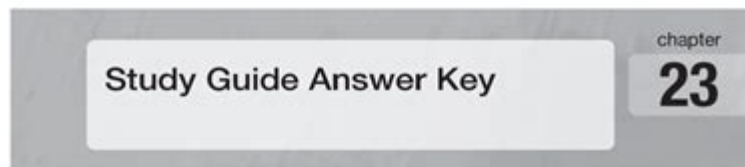

4. Answers should note that the eustachian tube has not matured and lies horizontally instead of at a 45-degree angle. 18. Wipe from the inner canthus downward and away from the opposite eye, use separate wipes for each eye, and perform frequent hand hygiene.
