### 2. SENTENCE STRUCTURE

Understanding sentence structure is crucial for effective communication. Modern English typically follows a subject-verb-object (SVO) order. For example:

- SUBJECT: THE CAT
- VERB: CHASED
- OBJECT: THE MOUSE.

HOWEVER, SENTENCES CAN VARY IN COMPLEXITY. HERE ARE A FEW TYPES OF SENTENCE STRUCTURES:

## COMMON USAGE ISSUES IN MODERN ENGLISH

EVEN PROFICIENT SPEAKERS AND WRITERS CAN ENCOUNTER USAGE ISSUES IN MODERN ENGLISH. HERE ARE SOME COMMON PITFALLS TO AVOID:

## 1. SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT

SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT REFERS TO THE GRAMMATICAL RULE THAT THE SUBJECT AND VERB MUST AGREE IN NUMBER. A SINGULAR SUBJECT REQUIRES A SINGULAR VERB, WHILE A PLURAL SUBJECT REQUIRES A PLURAL VERB. FOR EXAMPLE:

- CORRECT: THE TEAM IS WINNING.
- INCORRECT: THE TEAM ARE WINNING.

### 2. PRONOUN-ANTECEDENT AGREEMENT

PRONOUNS MUST AGREE WITH THEIR ANTECEDENTS IN NUMBER AND GENDER. FOR INSTANCE:

- CORRECT: EACH STUDENT MUST SUBMIT HIS OR HER ASSIGNMENT.
- INCORRECT: EACH STUDENT MUST SUBMIT THEIR ASSIGNMENT.

WHILE THE USE OF "THEY" AS A SINGULAR, GENDER-NEUTRAL PRONOUN IS BECOMING MORE ACCEPTED, IT'S IMPORTANT TO MAINTAIN CLARITY IN YOUR WRITING.

## 3. MISPLACED MODIFIERS

A MISPLACED MODIFIER CAN LEAD TO CONFUSION. ENSURE THAT MODIFIERS ARE PLACED NEXT TO THE WORD THEY ARE MEANT TO MODIFY. FOR EXAMPLE:

- CORRECT: SHE ALMOST DROVE HER KIDS TO SCHOOL EVERY DAY.
- INCORRECT: SHE DROVE HER KIDS TO SCHOOL ALMOST EVERY DAY.

## 4. PASSIVE VS. ACTIVE VOICE

ACTIVE VOICE IS GENERALLY PREFERRED IN MODERN ENGLISH WRITING BECAUSE IT IS MORE DIRECT AND ENGAGING. IN ACTIVE VOICE, THE SUBJECT PERFORMS THE ACTION, WHEREAS, IN PASSIVE VOICE, THE SUBJECT RECEIVES THE ACTION. FOR EXAMPLE:

- ACTIVE: THE TEACHER GRADED THE EXAMS.
- PASSIVE: THE EXAMS WERE GRADED BY THE TEACHER.

WHILE PASSIVE VOICE CAN BE APPROPRIATE IN SOME CONTEXTS, IT'S OFTEN BEST TO USE ACTIVE VOICE FOR CLARITY AND CONCISENESS.

## IMPROVING YOUR WRITING SKILLS
