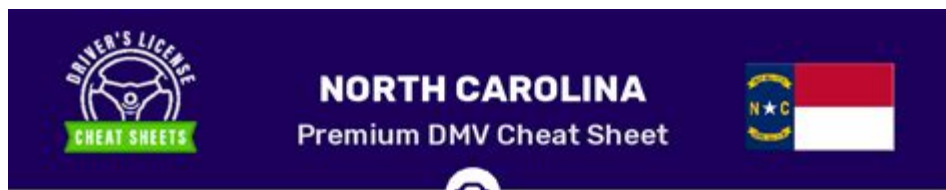

- \$21.50 for a Limited Learner Permit (Level 1)
- \$21.50 for a Limited Provisional License (Level 2)
- \$5.50 per year for a Class C Driver License
- Additional fees may apply.
