WHAT THE JOB ENTAILS: Plant Maintainer (Hospital/Tender) (HHC), under supervision, install, adjust, maintain and kind power plant, pumping, heating, ventilation and air conditioning equipment and related systems serving hospital and health care facilities; perform related work.

Plant Maintainer (Hospital/Tender) (HHC) performs the duties and functions of Plant Maintainer (Hospital/Tender) (HHC), viz., inspect, adjust, repair and/or kind equipment used in heating, ventilating, refrigeration, air conditioning and related mechanical systems (pumps and related machinery, gauges and other controls of operating equipment, such as valves and related machinery, and related systems, except that where equipment operates a New York City High Pressure Boiler or refrigeration machinery operator's license may exist in this function, viz., if necessary, to operate machinery, kind the High Pressure Boiler using cold fuels, check boilers, run down the boiler under suitable equipment associated with the heating, ventilating, refrigeration, air conditioning mechanical systems and related operational, such as equipment parts, as required and maintain work records and logs.

Some of the physical activities performed by Plant Maintainer (Hospital/Tender) (HHC) are environmental conditions, equipment, air, drilling, steam, boilers and/or boiler room equipment, standing upright for extended periods of time, using vision to read small numbers and markings on gauges and equipment, carrying items and having to stand in part from mechanical piping and related machinery, maintaining steady balance while working continuously, walking over wet and slippery surfaces, working in areas containing gases from the combustion process and strong odors from gases, lubricants and oil, working in confined areas inside boilers and other piping, which may be dirty and dark, lifting metal objects weighing up to 60 pounds, and working with alkaline and acidic chemicals used in boiler water treatment.

THE SALARY: The current minimum salary is \$24.94 per hour. This rate is subject to change.

Education and Experience Requirements: By the last day of the Application Period you must have:

Qualification Requirements:

- Three years of full-time satisfactory experience acquired within the last ten years in the installation, maintenance, and repair of boilers, electricals, air conditioning or related equipment, or in the operation and maintenance of high pressure boilers; or
- Not less than one and one-half years of experience as described in "1" above plus sufficient training of a relevant nature acquired in an approved trade or vocational high school to make up the equivalent of the foregoing required experience. Six months of acceptable experience will be credited for each year of approved trade or vocational high school.
