WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES: Associate Job Opportunity Specialists, under general supervision, with some latitude for independent judgment, decision making and action, supervise a Job Center job opportunity team or perform the team's work. All personnel perform related work.
(This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)

THE SALARY: The current minimum salary is \$36,365 per annum. This rate is subject to change. There are three assignment levels within this class of positions. Appointments to the highest assignment levels are made at the discretion of the agency.

HOW TO APPLY: If you believe you are eligible to take this examination, refer to the "Required Forms" section below for the forms that you must fill out. Return all completed forms and the application fee to DCAS, Applications Section, 1 Center Street, 14th Floor, New York, NY 10007 by mail only. Applications will not be accepted in person.

ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE EXAMINATIONS: This examination is open to each employee of an agency under the jurisdiction of the Commission, Department of Citywide Administrative Services who, on the date of the multiple-choice test:
(1) is permanently (not previously) employed or is or appears on a Preferred List (see Note, below) for the title of Job Opportunity Specialist; and
(2) is not otherwise ineligible.
(Note: A "Preferred List" is a civil service list which is only for certain former permanent incumbents of the eligible title who have retiring rights.)
If you do not know your permanent title or whether you are on a Preferred List, check with your agency's personnel office. If you are marked "not eligible", your application fee will not be refunded and your test papers will not be read.
You may be given the test before a review of your eligibility.

ELIGIBILITY TO BE PROMOTED: In order to be eligible for promotion, you must have completed your probationary period in the eligible title as indicated in the above "Eligibility To Take Examinations" section, and you must be permanently assigned to an eligible title or your name must appear on a Preferred List for the eligible title at the time of promotion. Additionally, you must have served permanently in an eligible title for at least one year.

Residency: City residency is not required for this position.
