

Nys Notary Exam Schedule

All exam requests will be responded to in the order of receipt. When your request has been processed, you will receive an email confirmation with your exam date and time. Do not report to an exam site unless you receive email confirmation of your scheduled exam date and time. Arrive to your exam 15 minutes prior to the start time. Those who appear at an exam site unscheduled or after the exam start time, will be turned away.
