- o Enclosed footwear (no thongs or sandals)
- o High visibility vest or other similar clothing
- o Other protective clothing or equipment as required for the workplace

If the above conditions cannot be met, your employee may be trained and tested at our training centre in Northcote.

All applicants must learn our training manual and complete the student workbook as supplied in the booking confirmation email.

All applicants must be 18 years of age or over.

They must have basic English skills, as they will be required to answer test questions in English. (Note: A verbal assessment can be conducted if written English is a challenge.)
