

## **FAQ - Entry in Cyprus | Migration Department**

If you hold a valid temporary residence permit, you can re-enter Cyprus by presenting the permit and valid passport, provided that you have not stayed abroad for more than three months.

#### Visas - Gov.cv

Multiple entry Visas (up to 5 years) are granted to third country nationals who provide proof of frequent visits to Cyprus and other EU countries. Similarly to the Short stay Visa, the duration of

stay should not exceed the three months in any half year, starting from the date of first entry.

#### CONSULATE GENERAL OF THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS IN ST.

Since June 2014 Cyprus accepts a valid Schengen Visa (category C, double or multiple entry) equivalent to its national visa for transit through or intended stay on its territory not exceeding 90 days in any 180-day period.

Therefore, persons travelling to Cyprus are advised to enter Cyprus only through legal border crossings. Persons wishing to take up employment in Cyprus must have a work permit issued by the Civil Registry and Migration Department of the Cyprus Ministry of Interior.

## Embassy of the Republic of Cyprus to the Hague - Visiting / ...

Third country nationals, holders of a valid Schengen visa (type: double or multiple entry), who have already entered the Schengen area in accordance with the terms upon which their Schengen visa was issued, may travel to Cyprus without a visa and stay for a period equal to the remainder of the time for which the Schengen visa is valid.

## Cyprus Visa and Residence Types: How to Travel to Cyprus in 2025

Jun 25,  $2025 \cdot$  However, if they hold a valid Schengen multi-entry visa, long-stay visa, or residence permit issued by a Schengen country, they can enter Cyprus for up to 90 days without additional documents.

#### Cyprus Visa Requirements for Egyptian citizens in 2025

Jun 7,  $2024 \cdot$  For Egyptian citizens looking to travel to Cyprus, securing a visa prior to arrival is mandatory. Please consult the nearest Cyprus embassy or consulate for detailed visa application procedures.

## Embassy of the Republic of Cyprus in Paris - Consular

Holders of a Residence Permit issued by a member state of the European Union (excluding Turkey and Azerbaïdjan) can travel to Cyprus without a visa, with their valid national passport and residence permit.

#### CYPRUS CHECKLIST FOR T VISA CYPRUS - VFS Global

If applicant has a valid, double and / or multiple entries Schengen visa on his/ her passport, he/she can enter Cyprus without a visa.Please note that no visa is required even if the Schengen Visa is not previously used to enter the country of issue).

#### **Cyprus Residence Permit - Temporary and Permanent Residence Permits**

Any foreign national who wants to live in Cyprus has to obtain a Cyprus residence permit. The Cyprus residence permit is what allows foreigners to legally move and live in Cyprus for longer than

three months.
