### Poetic Devices Worksheet 3 | Answer Key

1. Onomatopoeia, rhythm, rhyme, consonance

#### 3. Alliteration, rhyme, rhythm

Alliteration: the words morning and mingles both begin with the M sound.

Rhyme: the words gloom and broom have the same final sound as well as the words aisle and awhile.

Rhythm: The poem has a back and forth rhythm that trails off at the end, almost as the character loses her rhythm when she begins dreaming.

4. Onomatopoeia, alliteration, consonance, rhyme, rhythm, repetition

Onomatopoeia: the pronunciation of the words ripping, quack,

clacking, and trilling imitates their respective sounds.

Alliteration: the words ripping and racking both begin with the R sound. The

words trilling and toad both begin with the T sound.

Consonance: the words ripping and racking end in similar consonant sounds but do not rhyme, as do the words clacking and trilling.

Rhyme: the words toad and road rhyme as well as the words racking and clacking.

Rhythm: The lines begin with a pounding sort of rhythm but gets shorter and

bumpier at the end

Repetition: The words listen and horn are both repeated perhaps for rhetorical effect.
