
# **Piano Cheat Sheet For Beginners**

# **Reading Music**

- The notes in the spaces are F, A, C, E (which spells FACE).

For the bass clef, the lines from bottom to top are G, B, D, F, A (Good Boys Do Fine Always) and the spaces are A, C, E, G (All Cows Eat Grass).

## **Basic Piano Chords**

Chords are essential for playing songs. Here are the basic chords that every beginner should learn:

# 1. Major Chords

A major chord consists of three notes: the root, the major third, and the perfect fifth.

- C Major: C E G
- D Major: D F A
- E Major: E G B
- F Major: F A C
- G Major: G B D
- A Major: A C E
- B Major: B D F

## 2. Minor Chords

A minor chord consists of the root, the minor third, and the perfect fifth.

- C Minor: C Eb G
- D Minor: D F A
- E Minor: E G B
- F Minor: F Ab C
- G Minor: G Bb D
- A Minor: A C E
- B Minor: B D F

### 3. Seventh Chords

Seventh chords add a bit of complexity and richness to your playing.

```
- C7: C - E - G - Bb
```

# **Piano Scales**

Scales are the building blocks of music. Practicing scales helps improve finger strength and dexterity.

# 1. Major Scales

Here's how to play a C Major scale:

- Start on C and play: C - D - E - F - G - A - B - C

To play other major scales, use the formula of whole and half steps:

- Whole, Whole, Half, Whole, Whole, Half.

### 2. Minor Scales

For the A Minor scale, you'll play:

- Whole, Half, Whole, Whole, Half, Whole, Whole.

<sup>-</sup> F7: F - A - C - Eb

# 2. Chord Progressions

- I-IV-V-I: C - F - G - C
- ii-V-I: Dm - G - C
```
