- Ellos/Ellas/Ustedes: -en

Example with the verb "comer" (to eat):

- Yo como (I eat)
- Tú comes (You eat)
- Él/Ella/Usted come (He/She/You eat)
- Nosotros/Nosotras comemos (We eat)
- Vosotros/Vosotras coméis (You all eat)
- Ellos/Ellas/Ustedes comen (They/You all eat)

-IR Verbs

The conjugation pattern for regular -ir verbs is as follows:

- Yo: -o
- Tú: -es
- Él/Ella/Usted: -e
- Nosotros/Nosotras: -imos
- Vosotros/Vosotras: -ís
- Ellos/Ellas/Ustedes: -en

Example with the verb "vivir" (to live):

- Yo vivo (I live)
- Tú vives (You live)
- Él/Ella/Usted vive (He/She/You live)
- Nosotros/Nosotras vivimos (We live)
- Vosotros/Vosotras vivís (You all live)
