6th day	Take 1 tablet before breakfast.	

**\*Instructions:** Unless otherwise directed by your physician, all six (6) tablets in the row labeled 1st day should be taken the day you receive your prescription. If it is received late in the day, take two tablets every hour for the first day only, then follow directions as printed.

Gently peel back white layer at TAB before pushing tablet out of foil.
