- APOTHECARY SYSTEM:
- 1 OUNCE (OZ) = 30 MILLILITERS (ML)
- 1 GRAIN (GR) = 65 MILLIGRAMS (MG)
- HOUSEHOLD MEASUREMENTS:
- 1 TEASPOON (TSP) = 5 MILLILITERS (ML)
- 1 TABLESPOON (TBSP) = 15 MILLILITERS (ML)
