Ending Reconstruction



By the 1870s, Reconstruction was growing widely unpopular in the South. Radical Republicans lost influence during the 1870s, and Reconstruction slowed down. In 1875, Southern Democrats in Mississippi used violence to take control. President Grant refused to send federal troops to help. In Mississippi, this showed the South that the federal government was no longer supportive of Reconstruction.

The election of 1876 would result in the end of Reconstruction and lead to democratic control of the South. The Democratic Party won control of the House of Representatives for the first time since the Civil War. Presidential candidate Rutherford B. Hayes won the election by promising democrats control of the South. The election of 1876 ended Reconstruction—but civil rights for black Americans would be a long, hard-fought battle for the next 100 years.
