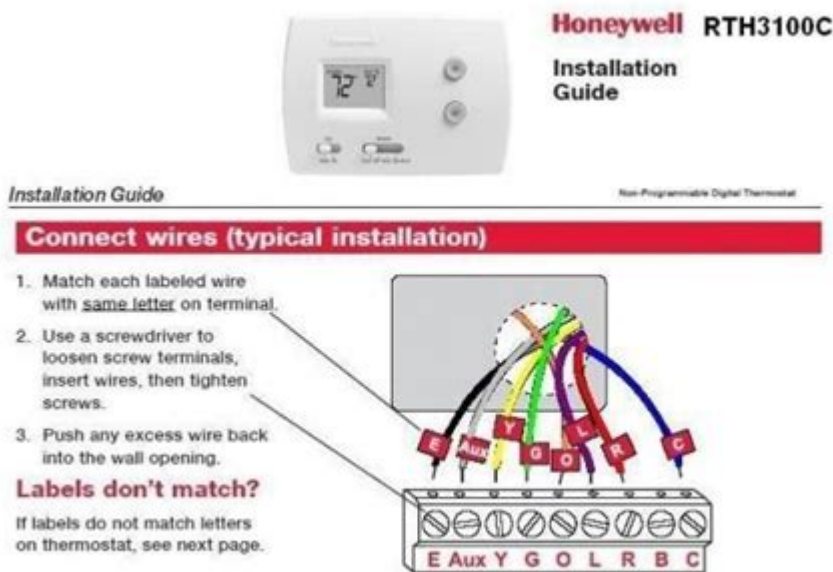


Rth6580wf Installation Manual
