



# Screen Linux Cheat Sheet

## Screen Keybindings

Screen manager with VT100/ANSI terminal emulation

Precede all commands by **^A** (**Ctrl** + **A**)<sup>1</sup>

<b>*</b>	Switch to window name/number	<b>p ^h</b> 	Switch to previous window <sup>3</sup>
<b>"</b>	Show window list	<b>Q</b>	Send literal <b>^Q</b> (XON) to current window
<b>0..9</b>	Switch to window <b>0..9</b>	<b>Q</b>	Delete all but the current region
<b>-</b>	Switch to the blank window	<b>r</b>	Toggle line-wrap for current window <sup>3</sup>
	Switch input focus to next region	<b>S</b>	Send literal <b>^S</b> (XOFF) to current window <sup>3</sup>
<b>^a</b>	Switch to previous window <sup>3</sup>	<b>S</b>	Split current region horizontally

<b>f</b>	Toggle flow between <b>on</b> , <b>off</b> , <b>auto</b> <sup>3</sup>	<b>Z</b>	Reset virtual terminal values
<b>F</b>	Resize window to current region size	<b>.</b>	Dump termcap to <b>.termcap</b>

### Notes

- <sup>1</sup> Command character is **^A** by default. Override with the **-e** option
- <sup>2</sup> Command character typed twice by default (e.g., becomes **]]** if the command character is set to **]** using the **-e** option)
- <sup>3</sup> Commands bound to lowercase letters are bound to their control character counterparts (e.g., **^A c** is equivalent to **^A ^c**)

## Screen Linux Cheat Sheet

The GNU Screen is a powerful terminal multiplexer that allows users to manage multiple terminal sessions from a single window. It is especially useful for those who work on remote servers or need to run processes that should continue even after disconnecting. ## Installation

exit

- Create a new window:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a c
```
```

- Switch to the next window:

```bash
Ctrl+a n
```
```

- Switch to the previous window:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a p
```
```

- List all windows:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a "
```
```

- Close the current window:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a &
```
```

## Advanced Features

Screen offers a variety of advanced features that enhance its usability, especially for power users.

### Scrolling and Copying Text

- Enter copy mode:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a [
```
```

- Scroll up/down:

Use the arrow keys or `Page Up/Page Down`.

- Select text:

Move the cursor to the start of the text you want to copy, press `Space`, move to the end of the text, and then press `Space` again.

- Paste the copied text:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a ]
```
```

### Session Management

- Rename the current window:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a A
```
```

- Send a command to all windows:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a :
```
```

Then type the command you want to send.

- Lock the screen:

```
```bash
Ctrl+a x
```
```

```

## Customizing Screen

Screen can be customized through its configuration file, typically located at `~/.screenrc`. Here are some common customizations you can apply:

- Set default window title:

```
```bash
caption always "%{= kw}%-w%{= r} %n %t %{=} %-w%{= k} %="
```
```

- Enable mouse support:

```
```bash
mousesupport on
```
```

- Change scrollback buffer size:

```
```bash
defscrollback 10000
```
```

## Useful Tips and Tricks

- Log all output to a file:

You can log the output of a Screen session to a file by starting the session with:

```
```bash
screen -L
```
