The Five Elements of a Good Story (for ages 6-9)

This lesson will help you think about the five basic elements you need when you write a story—any story that has a character and a problem, like the Circle C stories. (Parents can read this to their younger children.)

A Story Is Like a Puzzle

A story is not just a bunch of words tossed down on paper. A story is made up of smaller pieces—"elements"—just like a jigsaw puzzle. Each piece (element) of the story goes together like putting together a puzzle. If you are missing a piece of your puzzle, the whole puzzle doesn't turn out. If you are missing a piece of your story, the whole story doesn't turn out.





The Five "Puzzle Pieces" of a Story

Here is a jigsaw puzzle of the Five Elements of a Story. You need each one of these to make sure your story is complete. If you forget to include a piece, your story may turn into the "never-ending" story.

Here are the Five Story Elements:

- <u>CHARACTERS</u>: Who is in the story? Both a main character and helping characters. Characters can be animals too!
- SETTING: Where does your story take place?
- <u>PROBLEM:</u> What problem does the main character need to solve? No problem = No story = Boring.
- <u>PLOT</u>: This means "What happens in the story while the character is solving her problem?" So plot and problem go together.
- SOLUTION: You can't just write "The End" when you get tired of writing your story. Your character must solve the original problem or at least learn how to live with it. If not, the story goes on and on and never really "ends."
