- At first Dalton thought the atom was solid, spherical, **indivisible**, then Rutherford discovered the **nucleus** of the atom, then the subatomic particles **protons**, **neutrons**, and **electrons** were discovered
- The positively charged particle is the **proton** found in the **nucleus** of the atom
- The subatomic particle that has about the same mass as the proton, but with no electrical charge, is called a **neutron** and is found in the **nucleus** of the atom
- The **electron** is negatively charged and is found in the **electron cloud** outer shell of the atom
- Bohr** is the person credited with placing electrons on levels and **Schrodinger** established the electron cloud theory.
- The forces that hold the particles together in the nucleus are **columbic/electrostatic** forces
- Isotopes are atoms of the same element that **have different number of neutrons**
- All isotopes of hydrogen contain **1 proton & 1 electron**

- Zinc -66 has **30** protons and **36** neutrons
