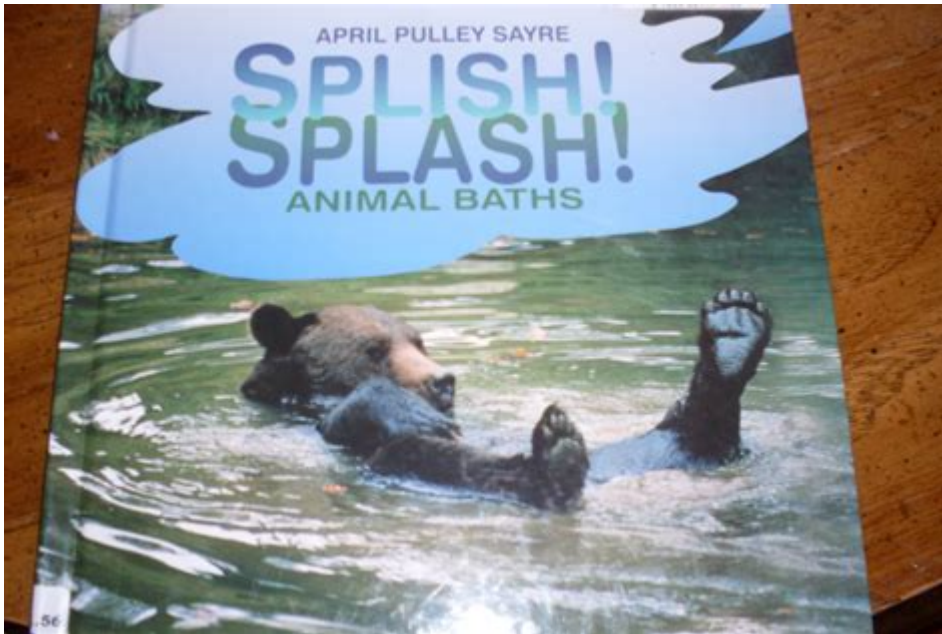


Splish Splash Animal Baths

4. TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

- BATHING CAN BE PART OF OBEDIENCE TRAINING.
- TEACHING PETS TO ENJOY BATH TIME CAN REDUCE STRESS DURING VET VISITS.

HOW OFTEN SHOULD YOU BATHE YOUR PET?

THE FREQUENCY OF BATHS VARIES DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF ANIMAL, THEIR BREED, AND LIFESTYLE. HERE'S A GENERAL GUIDELINE:

- DOGS: TYPICALLY, DOGS SHOULD BE BATHED EVERY 4 TO 6 WEEKS. HOWEVER, ACTIVE DOGS OR THOSE WITH SKIN CONDITIONS MAY NEED MORE FREQUENT BATHS.

- OTHER PETS: BIRDS, REPTILES, AND OTHER ANIMALS MAY HAVE SPECIFIC BATHING NEEDS BASED ON THEIR SPECIES.

PREPARING FOR BATH TIME

BEFORE DIVING INTO BATH TIME, IT'S CRUCIAL TO PREPARE ADEQUATELY TO ENSURE A SMOOTH EXPERIENCE.

1. GATHER SUPPLIES

- PET-FRIENDLY SHAMPOO: CHOOSE A PRODUCT SPECIFICALLY FORMULATED FOR YOUR PET'S SPECIES AND SKIN TYPE.

3. PREPARE YOUR PET

- BRUSH YOUR PET BEFORE THE BATH TO REMOVE LOOSE FUR AND MATS.
- ENSURE YOUR PET IS CALM; CONSIDER TAKING A SHORT WALK BEFOREHAND TO EXPEND EXCESS ENERGY.

BATHING TECHNIQUES

1. BATHING DOGS

- **APPLY SHAMPOO:** USE A SMALL AMOUNT OF CAT-SPECIFIC SHAMPOO, APPLYING IT GENTLY AND AVOIDING THE FACE.
- **RINSE CAREFULLY:** RINSE WELL, ENSURING NO SHAMPOO REMAINS.
- **DRYING:** TOWEL DRY AND ALLOW THE CAT TO AIR DRY IN A WARM ROOM.

3. BATHING SMALL ANIMALS (RABBITS AND GUINEA PIGS)

- **SPOT CLEANING:** INSTEAD OF FULL BATHS, USE A DAMP CLOTH TO CLEAN DIRTY AREAS.

POST-BATH CARE

AFTER BATH TIME, IT'S ESSENTIAL TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR PET PROPERLY.

1. REWARD YOUR PET

- GIVE TREATS OR PRAISE TO CREATE A POSITIVE ASSOCIATION WITH BATH TIME.
- PLAY WITH THEM OR ENGAGE IN THEIR FAVORITE ACTIVITY.

2. MONITOR FOR SKIN REACTIONS

- KEEP AN EYE ON YOUR PET FOR ANY SIGNS OF IRRITATION OR ALLERGIC REACTIONS.
- CONSULT YOUR VETERINARIAN IF YOU NOTICE ANY UNUSUAL BEHAVIOR OR SKIN ISSUES.

3. MAINTAIN GROOMING ROUTINE

- REGULARLY BRUSH YOUR PET'S COAT TO PREVENT MATTING AND REDUCE SHEDDING.
- SCHEDULE PERIODIC BATHS BASED ON YOUR PET'S SPECIFIC NEEDS.
