 $-60(6) = -360$  feet

 $-10(40) = -400$  meters
- A freight train starts at 0 miles per hour. After 15 miles the train is traveling 90 miles per hour. What integer represents the average increase in speed per mile?  
 $90 \div 15 = 6$  miles per hour
